INSTRUCTIONS

In the week before:

- Organise what food and or drinks you wish to serve for supper.
- Organise who and what needs to be bought and or made.

Before the service:

- Set out cups/mugs, any utensils, and bowls and plates needed.
- Prepare any appropriate foods before hand, where possible, ready to serve.

After the service:

- Set out all food and drinks for self service.
- Serve any food or drink that requires attendance.

In conclusion:

- Collect, wash dirty crockery, cutlery.
- Clean down benches, tables.
- Put away all items.

Ideas of food and drink to serve:

- Hot chocolates, coffee, tea, etc.
- Cordials, soft drink, juices, etc.
- Sweets, crisps, biscuits, cakes, etc.

Tips:

- To make it easier for your team try and keep what you serve to a minimum. So only do one or two foods or drinks. For example just do hot chocolate and tim tams.
- You could give the night a theme to make it easier and more fun. For example red – only serve red foods, or mint – only serve foods with mint.
- Only put out foods that have very little preparation on the night. We don't want you missing the service because you are tossing stir fry in the church kitchen!!!

- **NB: If your Life Group is unable to do its rostered weeks, please arrange a swap with another Life Group or replace your Life Group with a new team of people.**
